Full training will be provided under the guidance of our quality department.

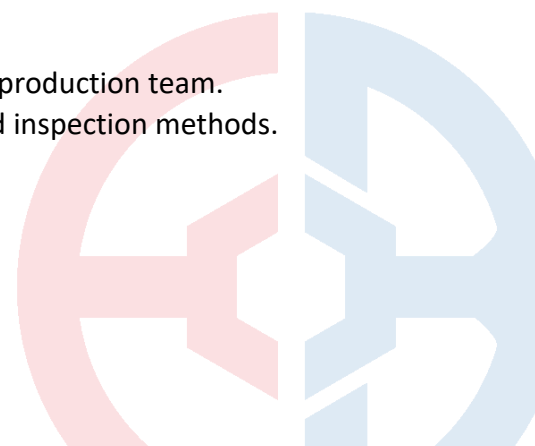
The Role
